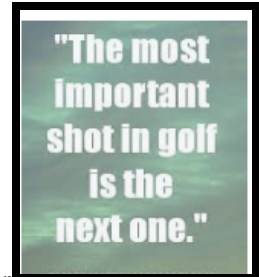


# Ladies League Reminders

*Enjoy your round and the company you are with today as life is short!  
Do your part, be on time, keep pace of play, respect the game, course, your fellow players and compete as ladies.  
Remember, you are simply playing against the course. Good luck!*

## 1. PLAYING RULES

- a. **PLEASE KEEP PACE OF PLAY!** Play ready golf!  
Guideline (Par 4 = 12 min Par 3 = 9 min Par 5 = 18 min) Total 1 hr 54 min
- b. Winter rules (with *integrity*) - you can move ball "~1 grip length" in your own fairway. Don't "move/fluff ball" in the rough!
  - Agree with opponents on relief (such as plugged mud balls, wet areas, ground under repair, etc.)
- c. Sand Traps: **Ground under Repair** - place ball and smooth foot prints on exit with feet.



## 2. HANDICAPS, TEES, MATCH SCORING...

- a. **ALL** players will have their full handicap. Your handicap is calculated using the average of the last 5 scores and is not an **official USGA HDCP**. It is only a league handicap done "our way". If you currently do not have a handicap, one will be calculated after you play one match.
- b. Handicap = Average - 36 **Example:** Say you shoot a 52 for your 1st score HDCP = 52 - 36 = 16
- c. Maximum Handicap is 18. (which means you need to average 54 to compete fairly)
- d. For *handicap purposes*, each hole score is "adjusted" to a max of "Net Double Bogey". (ex: max of 8 on a par 4)
- e. Choose a **TEE** to play and stay put for the season (*check score card to be sure designated tee is correct*).

Tee	18 Hole Yardage	Driver Distance	Tee	18 Hole Yardage	Driver Distance
<b>Red</b>	<b>4753</b>	<b>175</b>	<b>Orange</b>	<b>4022</b>	<b>150</b>

Remember, we do **NOT** use AGE for tee box criteria. Use the chart as a guide.  
Choose a tee that allows you to **enjoy** the game while still being **challenged** fairly!

Have some **INTEGRITY** in your choice!

- f. Double Par League Rule - If you decide to pick up on a hole you will record a "net double par" as follows:  
Hole Score = Double Par + strokes on hole (resulting in a "net double par")

- g. Each match is worth 20 pts

<b>HOLE PTS</b>	1 for low ball net and 1 for low total net	18 pts
<b>TEAM LOW NET</b>	Team Gross Score - handicaps	2 pts

## 3. END OF MATCH

- a. Review the card and agree to all **hole scores** before turning in. The computer will double check the scores and points for each team.
- b. Park cart by side hill, empty garbage, leave your cart key in the cart, and hand your scorecard to an employee (or leave on Pro Shop Counter or at the Bar). Thanks and see you next week!
